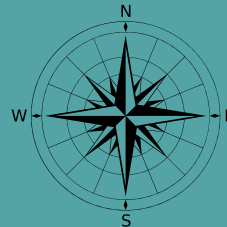


## What do we believe?

Research and evidence tells that Learning Coaches who are located in the North-East quadrant exhibit high levels of observable caring and learning relationships and high levels of effective pedagogies.

We believe the profile of an effective leader of learning includes the following:

1. A means of creating an extended family-like context for learning
2. A means of interacting with learners within this context in ways that allows the use of those teaching principles and practices that we know make a difference
3. A means of monitoring learners' progress and the impact of teaching practices on task and process learning and modifying teaching practices responsively.
