What is it?

Leading to the North East focuses on the implementation of evidence-based pedagogfv with fideltv, underpinned by quality teacher-learner relationships. Russell Bishop has combined years of research into a compleling rationale for leaders to follow, to unlock the potetial of every student. Developing quality relationships with learners. using evidene based pedagogy. in-class coaching and formative assessment practices are the keys to success.



Research and evidence tells that Learning Coaches who are located in the North-East quadrant exhibit high levels of observable caring and learning relationhships and high levels of effective pedagogies.

We believe the profile of an effective leader of learning includes the following:

- 1. A means of creating an extended family-like cntext for learning
- 2.A means of interacting with lerners within this context in ways that allows the use of those teaching principles and practices that we know make a difference
- 3. A means of monitoring learners' progress and the impact of teaching practices on task and process learning and modifying teaching practices responsively.
